Notes from the GM

Greetings Team MEIRA, I hope your year is well underway and all those New Year Resolutions are working for you. What about professional development goals? It's never too late!

As I celebrate a 60th birthday – wow, that came fast(!) – I thought it timely and relevant to remind ourselves why we persist in studying, seek professional qualifications and keep going.

year. I had asked our MEIRA Board directors how many of them had the CIRO, the much coveted IR qualification we offer in partnership with the UK IR Society. The IR certificate is used in many markets around the world from China to Chile with over 2,000 passes worldwide to date, 10% of which are in our region. When recently leading a CIRO Bootcamp, I was asked the same question of whether I had the CIRO. Suddenly, if not somewhat abashed, I felt compelled to take the test myself. After all, I have promoted the CIRO for 15 years and taught IR contents for longer than that without giving it two thoughts, as you conveniently do, to taking the actual exam.

We often think our study days are behind us – quite so, if you have been through the customary mill of rote learning – but continuous professional development is different. Since I started work in London in 1985, I have taken at least six sets of exams, all professionally driven, including having to meet local market requirements from London to Jakarta. When I finally sat the CIRO exam in December, I hadn't done an exam for 20 years. It's easy to forget how stressful it can be under exam conditions and allow your mind to wander, if not give up when you thought you knew it all – don't!

The CIRO is based on a comprehensive Study Guide, the best IR reference material I know – it's updated every few years to meet market needs across all key technical and market areas for IR practitioners. As part of the CIRO registration, you are given access to a mock test database to hone your knowledge prior to the exam – you can try that as many times as you like. The exam consists of 60 multiple choice questions – all the answers are there in front of you – and you have 60 minutes to complete it. The pass mark is 65%, so you have a reasonable margin for error if there are particularly tricky questions or if you don't understand all the questions. Sometimes, the English language can flummox even native speakers and it is part of the exam to test you and your knowledge of the Study Guide. If you prepare, you will pass.

I urge everyone from Board members to IR students for life to give it a go! It is the longest running and best known international IR qualification out there, as far as I am concerned. It is important to stay on top of your game and the CIRO will test you, as it should. In the end, you stand to gain a credible and much sought after qualification – ask fellow CIROs and prospective employers. It's never too late to teach an ol' dog (make that a water rabbit) new tricks, we swear by it, so try it!

Stay well and see you all soon, if not at the next CIRO Bootcamp and exam sitting.


